

These instructions are for TWO 15½" blocks

Nine 6½" purple squares

Nine 6½" pink squares

You will create eighteen Half-Square Triangle (HST) Units

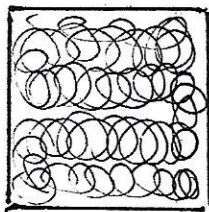
You will need two fat quarters for each block (one for each color). Or you can make it scrappy using your purples and pinks from your stash.

Layer one purple square and one pink square RIGHT SIDES together. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Draw a ¼" stitching line on either side of the center diagonal line. Sew on stitching lines. Using a ruler and a rotary cutter, separate the HST Units on the drawn diagonal line. Open each HST Unit and press toward the darker fabric.

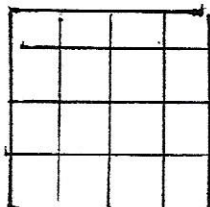
Trim each HST Unit to a 5½" square by carefully placing the 45 degree angle line on the ruler over the stitched seam of the HST Unit, checking that the 5½" lines fall within the HST Unit. Trim one corner (two sides) to a clean edge being careful to keep your corners square. Rotate the HST Unit and line up the 45 degree angle line on the ruler over the stitched seam again and trim to 5½".

Sew nine HST Units together as illustrated pressing the seams open.
