Card Trick

TWO 2 ½ " squares of fabric A, B, C, and D

ONE 2 ½" X 4 ½" rectangle of fabric A, B, C, and D

FOUR 2 ½" squares black

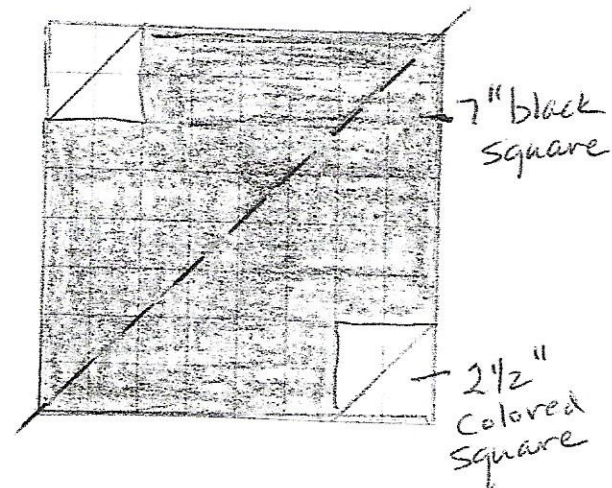
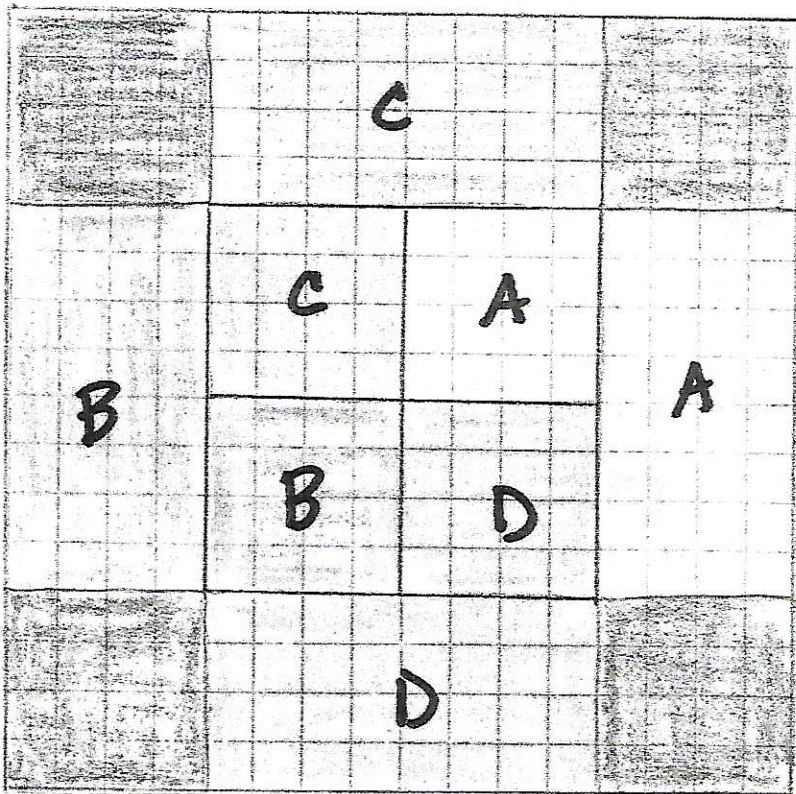
TWO 7" squares black

Make a 4 patch with one of the 2 ½" squares of each fabric A, B, C, and D.

Add a 2 ½" X 4 ½" rectangle to each side, matching the upper right corner fabric on the right side and the lower left corner fabric on the left side.

Attach a black 2 ½" square to each of the two remaining color rectangles. Add those pieces to the top and bottom of your 4 patch matching the upper left fabric and lower left fabric.

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the two remaining 2 ½" squares. Snowball those squares to the 7" black squares in opposite corners, stitching on the drawn line. Trim and press. Slash the black squares on the diagonal (corner to corner without the snowball). Add triangles to top and bottom centering them. Press. Add two remaining triangles to the sides, centering them. Press.
