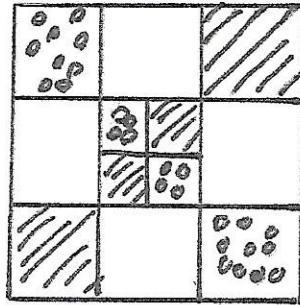


IT'S OK TO BE SQUARE

BOM 2019

9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " \times 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (finishes at 9" square)



Fabric A - tan

Fabric B - brown

Fabric C - rust

The following instructions will make one block

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

You will need:

Fabric A - tan/light brown

Fabric B - brown

Fabric C - rust

Cutting:

Fabric A - cut four 3 1/2 inch squares

Fabric B - cut two 3 1/2 inch squares
cut two 2 inch squares

Fabric C - cut two 3 1/2 inch squares
Cut two 2 inch squares

Assembling:

Sew a 2 inch rust square to a 2 inch brown square. Press toward brown fabric.

Sew the second 2 inch rust square to the second 2 inch brown square and press toward the brown fabric

Sew these two units together creating a four patch and press seam open.

Assemble the block as shown in the diagram.

Sew the fabric squares together creating rows - press toward tan fabric

Sew the three rows together - press away from the center
