Scrappy Pinwheel Puzzle

June 2018 Block of the Month

These directions will make two 8 ½ inch blocks.

Fabric:

- 1) tone-on-tone white, off white or light tan
- 2) a bright that will appeal to a child
- 1. From fabric one, cut one 7 inch square

two 2 ½ by 6 ½ inch rectangles (B)

two 2 ½ by 8 ½ inch rectangles (C)


2. From the bright fabric: cut one 7 inch square

Place the 7 inch squares right side together, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner.

Sew 1/4 inch on each side of the line.

Cut on the marked line, press to the colored side. Square up to 6 1/2 inches.

Sew B and C rectangles as shown on the diagram. (Pay attention to the angle of the colored piece when sewing B and C to the square.)
