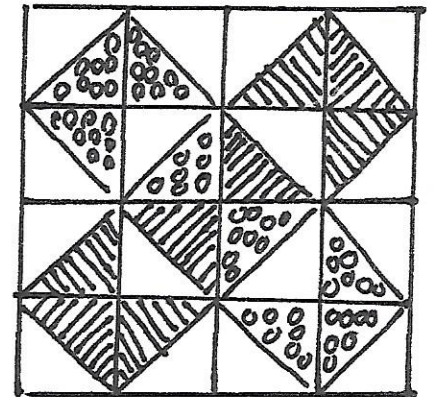
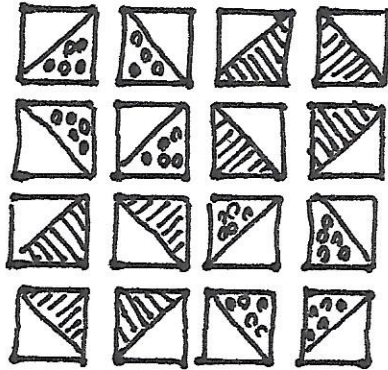


# MARCH MADNESS (It's a guy thing)

March 2018

12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " (finishes at 12" square)



The following instructions will make one block

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

You will need:

Fabric A - medium/medium dark - reads as solid



Fabric B - medium/medium dark print (no flowers please)



Fabric C - light brown/tan

Cutting:

Fabric A - cut four 4 inch squares

Fabric B - cut four 4 inch squares

Fabric C - cut eight 4 inch squares

Make half squares triangles :

Draw a diagonal line on the back of all 8 Fabric C tan squares.

Place them right sides together with the Fabric A and Fabric B squares (8 pairs)

Stitch a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on BOTH sides of the drawn line.

Cut apart on the drawn line.

Press seams open. Trim all squares to 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ ". You will have 16 2-colored squares.

Assemble the block as shown in the diagram.

Sew 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks together to form rows - 4 blocks in each row

Sew the four rows together

Press all seams open
