

Candy Twist

For one block

You will need:

Candy—Bright Fabric

Background—Tan

Cutting

Bright Fabric

One 5" square

One 4" square

Tan Fabric

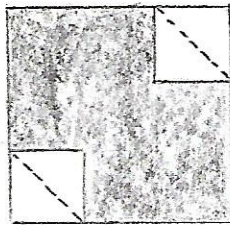
Two 2 1/2" squares

Two 3"x5" rectangles

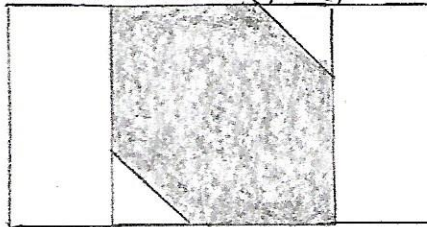
Two 3"x7 1/2" rectangles

One 4" square

Candy Body: Draw a diagonal line on the back of the 2 1/2" Tan squares. With right sides together place one 2 1/2" Tan square on the UPPER RIGHT corner and one 2 1/2" square on the LOWER LEFT corner of the 5" Bright square. Stitch along the diagonal line. Trim and press towards the Tan fabric



Sew the 3"x5" Tan rectangles to the sides of the Candy Body.



Half Square Triangle: Draw a diagonal line on the back of the Tan 4" square. Place the Bright 4" square and the Tan 4" square right sides together. Stitch a 1/4" seam on both sides of the drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line. Trim both half square triangles to a 3" square.

Sew the half square triangles to the 3"x7 1/2" rectangles so that they BOTH look like this.



Sew both rectangles (one top and one bottom) as shown to create your Candy Twist. Press all seams open. The block should measure $9\frac{1}{2}'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$.
