

## Scrappy Zig-Zag

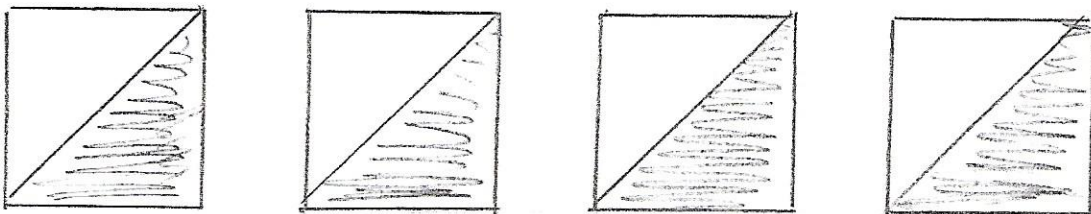
Cut (2) 6 inch squares of light fabric

Cut (2) 6 inch squares of dark fabric

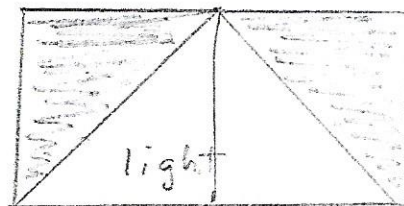
Mark center line from one corner to the opposite corner on the light fabrics.

Place a light square and a dark square right sides together and stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch away on either side of your marked center line. Cut apart and press to the dark fabric to make 2 half square triangle squares.

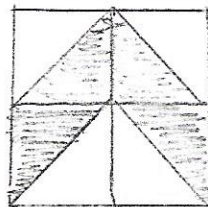
Repeat with the second light and dark fabric. You should now have 4 half square triangle squares. Trim these blocks to a  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square.



Sew two blocks together with the dark sides touching, and two with the light sides touching. Press seam open. See diagram:



Sew two rectangle blocks together with the tips of the triangle pointing up. Press seams open. Your block should measure  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " X  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " See completed block:
