

SPLIT NINE-PATCH

9" X 9" Block

The following instructions will make one block.

Press all seams open.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

You will need:

6 different reds

5 different creams or tans

From each of 4 of the reds cut:

1 3 1/2" square

From each of 2 of the reds cut:

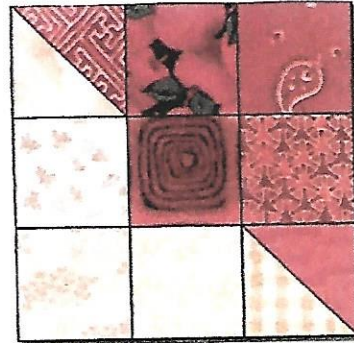
1 3 7/8" square

From each of 3 of the creams/tans cut:

1 3 1/2" square

From each of 2 of the creams/tans cut:

1 3 7/8" square



- Draw a diagonal line on the back of two cream 3 7/8" squares. Place them right sides together with two red 3 7/8" squares. Stitch a 1/4" seam on BOTH sides of the drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line. Press seams open. You will have 4 2-colored squares. (This will give you enough variety so that you have no duplicate fabrics in each block.)

- Assemble the red and cream/tan 3 1/2" squares and the 2-colored squares together in the arrangement shown above. Press all seams open.

- Block will measure 9 1/2" X 9 1/2"
