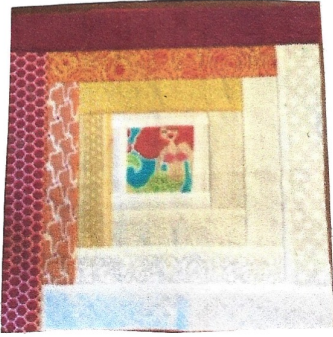


Adorable Log Cabin November 2022



For this BOM, you will be provided with a center square of a novelty print which has been bordered with a solid white fabric resulting in a 3 ½" square which has already been trimmed to that size.

Fabrics:

6 Brightly Colored Small Prints (e.g, 2 reds, 2 greens, 2 blues)

6 White (not off white) Tone on Tones (you could use 3 whites and use each twice)

All strips will be cut 1 ½" wide. Cut each strip the length as shown. Do not cut them longer and then trim to the required length, for it will not result in a block of the required dimensions. Press each strip toward the outside edge after sewing it onto the block. There are a lot of seams in this block which could result in a block that does not measure the desired dimensions. Measure the block after the application of each set of logs. If it doesn't match the indicated size, please make adjustments so that it does.

From the white fabric, cut:

1 strip 3 ½"

1 strip 4 ½"

1 strip 5 ½"

1 strip 6 ½"

1 strip 7 ½"

1 strip 8 ½"

From Each of the Color #1 Fabrics, cut:

1 strip 4 ½"

1 strip 5 ½"

From Each of the Color #2 Fabrics, cut:

1 strip 6 ½"

1 strip 7 ½"

From Each of the Color #3 Fabrics, cut:

1 strip 8 ½"

1 strip 9 ½"

To begin, stitch the White 3 ½" strip to the right side of the square. Press (after each application). Stitch the 4 ½" White strip to the bottom of the square. Stitch the Color #1 4 ½" strip to the left side of the square. Stitch the 5 ½" strip to the top of the square. The resulting square should measure 5 ½".

Begin the second round by stitching the 5 ½" White strip to the right side of the square. Stitch the 6 ½" White strip to the bottom of the square. Stitch the Color #2 6 ½" strip to the left side of the square. Stitch the Color #2 7 ½" strip to the top of the square. The resulting square should measure 7 ½".

Begin the third round by stitching the 7 ½" White strip to the right side of the square. Stitch the 8 ½" White strip to the bottom of the square. Stitch the Color #3 8 ½" strip to the left side of the square. Stitch the Color #3 9 ½" strip to the top of the square. The resulting square should measure 9 ½".
