

Monadnock Quilters' Guild Yardage Sale Guidelines

The goal of the Yardage Sale is to raise funds for the Guild's coffers and to assist our members in weeding out some unwanted quilting items.

In order to ensure that everyone has a good experience and that it raises funds, we would ask the membership to abide by the following guidelines:

- **General Rules:**
 - We would like everyone to bring at least one item
 - Only quilt-related items (although you could sneak in some knitting items)
 - Bring only stuff you would buy yourself
 - Everything needs to be in good serviceable condition
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- **Fabrics:**
 - Package or bundle fabric with approximate yardage on tag
 - Package so that all fabrics in the bundle can be seen
 - Where appropriate, bundle similar colors and/or types of fabric together
 - Tie bundle with ribbon, yarn or selvedge
 - No outdated or fussy-cut fabrics
 - Quilting fabrics only. Let's leave the polyester at home for retro leisure suits.
 - No fabric smaller than a fat quarter
 - Only yardage of 2+ yards can be a separate item
- The more information on the label, the easier it will be for buyers
- Patterns must have all the pieces and instructions
- Tools should have instructions, if at all possible
- Books should be in serviceable condition and contain up to date designs (i.e., no templates except for appliqué or something unique).

All sales are final.
