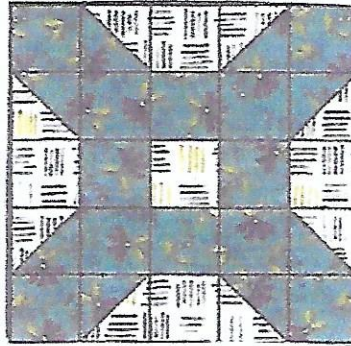


**Domino
Block of the Month
2024**



This block should measure 10 ½" which will finish as 10" when stitched into a quilt. The instructions make one block. You will need any shade of **blue** in a small print or blue tone on tone and an **off white or cream** in a solid or tone on tone. These instructions make one block.

From the **blue** fabric cut:

Twelve 2 ½" squares
Four 3" squares

From the off white or cream fabric cut:

Five 2 ½" squares
Four 3" squares

Draw a diagonal line of the back of the four off white 3" squares. Pair them with the four blues squares with right sides together. Stitch ¼" on each side of the drawn line.

Cut on the line. Press the seam open. Trim the squares to 2 ½".

Assemble the squares as shown in the diagram.

Press all seams open.
