

MQG Block Of Month 2026

Disappearing Nine-Patch

Makes one 13½" unfinished block

¼" seams throughout this pattern!



Fabric Requirements:

Color 1 White (4) 5" Squares

Color 2 Red (2) 5" Squares

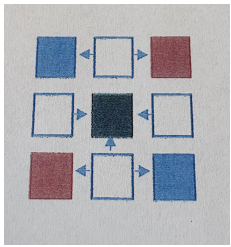
Color 3 Blue (2) 5" Squares

Color 4 Black (1) 5" Square

For more accurate blocks, press seams as directed in the instructions.

Do not skip any pressing steps

Instructions:

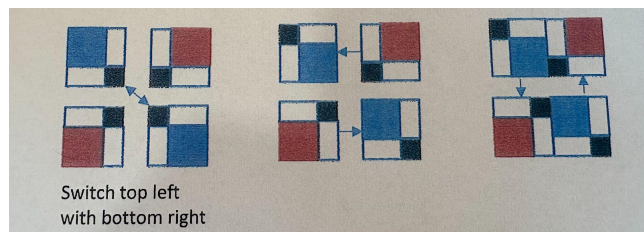
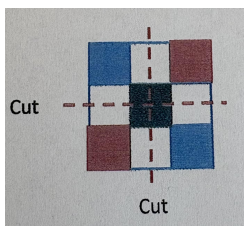


1. Lay out all nine squares into 3 rows of squares. Blue, white red. White, black, white and Red, white, blue. Like the *image on left*

2. Sew each row, pressing seams towards the dark squares.

3. Sew the rows together, press seams towards the center. Block should measure 14"

4. Cut the block in half both horizontally & vertically.



5. Without turning the pieces, switch the top left and bottom right sections. Sew the four square units like pictured above pressing seams towards the larger dark square.

6. Sew the rows together, pressing seams towards the smaller squares. Press seam open.

OR spin the center for a flatter block (to do this use your fingers to fold open the seam in the center of the block having half the seam fold in one direction and the other half fold the other direction. It will look like a little 4 patch on the back)
