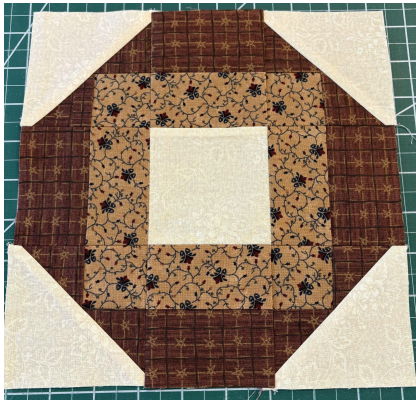


MQG Block Of Month 2026

The Kitchen Woodbox

Makes One 9½" unfinished block



Scant ¼" seams throughout this pattern!

Fabric Requirements:

Color 1 Brown (country kitchen vibe)

(4) 2 ⅜" Squares and (1) 2" x 14" Strip

Color 2 Medium Brown/Tan (country color print on it ok)

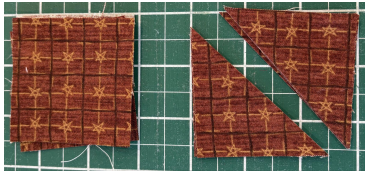
(4) 2" Squares and (1) 2" x 14" Strip

Color 3 Cream Tone on Tone

(2) 3 ⅞" Squares and (1) 3½" Square

For more accurate blocks, press seams as directed in the instructions. **Do not skip any pressing steps**

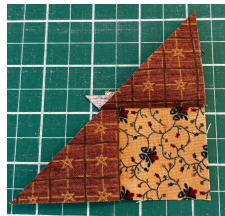
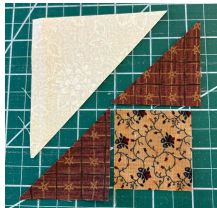
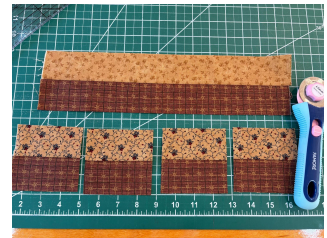
Instructions:



1. Take Color 1 four 2 ⅜" squares and stack them, then cut diagonally making (8) triangles.

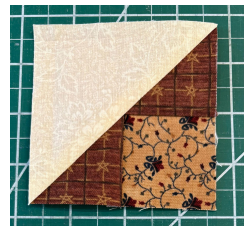
2. Take Color 3 two 3 ⅞" squares and do the same as step 1. Making (4) triangles.

3. Using a scant ¼" seam, sew Color 1 and Color 2 2" x 14" strips right sides together along one long side. **Press seam to the light side**, so the seams will nest when sewn to the units below. Cut this unit into four 3 ½" squares



4. To make the block's corner units, Sew color 1 triangle to the left and top edges of Color 2's 2" square. Trim dog ears. **Press the seam towards the triangle**

5. Add Color 3 triangle to the pieced triangle, **Press seam to the light side**. Make 4 **These should measure 3 ½"**



6. Lay out all units as shown in photo to the left, with the Color 3 3 ½" square in the center. Sew three horizontal rows, **alternating pressing directions by row**. Join the rows, and **press those two seams open**
